All responses will be confidential between individual applicants and members of the Area Prescribing Committee (APC), Area Prescribing Group (APG) or New Medicine Committee (NMC). The onus will be with individual applicants to inform the Secretary of the Committee as and when changes occur. It is the responsibility of individual applications or committee members to declare at APC, APG or NMC meetings any specific conflict of interest in relation to specific agenda items.

Interests which may cause conflict can include:

- Owning or being a major shareholder in a company associated with pharmaceuticals and marketing.
- Being employed or acting as a consultant to a pharmaceutical or marketing company, on either a permanent or occasional basis.
- Sponsorships of individuals, departments, or employing Trusts pharmaceutical companies.
- Financial benefits accruing from commissioning of commercial clinical trials.
